The Altrusa International Foundation's Club 21 program was established in 1997 to support children with HIV/AIDS. HIV/AIDS is a global epidemic, affecting people in all countries and from all walks of life, but innocent children bear the brunt of this disease. Club 21 gives Altrusans the opportunity to extend their hands to these children and their families. With an annual contribution of \$21 (US) or more to the Altrusa International Foundation, you will become a member of Club 21. As a member you will receive the special gold and white Club 21 pin, signifying your participation in a program of which Altrusans are proud.

Since its inception, Club 21 has funded Safe Haven Camps for children with HIV/AIDS. Camp Safe Haven is free of charge to the children, and the entire staff of professionals and volunteers donate their time and services. Funding from Club 21 also sponsors the Ghana Health Education Initiative in Africa which provides HIV/AIDS education to a population that badly needs it.

At the February 2006 Board of Trustees meeting in Chicago, the Board approved moving from a quarterly Club 21 renewal schedule to a yearly schedule. From now on Club 21 members will have a chance every August to fill out a renewal form found in *The Altrusan*. Members also have the option of including their Club 21 renewal in their response to the yearly Foundation solicitation.
